Christie's Hong Kong 2018 Spring Sale Totals HK\$3.11bn/US\$399m

Highest Ever Evening Sale Total
Global Participation and Strong Appetite for Masterpieces







3 Top Lots across art and luxury categories each achieved over HK\$100m

Hong Kong, 30 May 2018- Christie's Hong Kong Spring Sales realised HK\$3.11bn / US\$399m from 18 sales across 6 days.

Rebecca Wei, Christie's President Asia said "The strong results bear testament to the depth of our global client base, with three works across art and luxury categories having each achieving in excess of HK\$100m. As collectors pursued masterpieces across all categories, notable auction results were achieved, propelling iconic Asian masters such as Zao Wou-Ki to new heights of international recognition. The market also responded enthusiastically to our innovative curation which saw the highest ever evening sale total in our history as we surpassed HK\$1bn in sales and introduced our most ambitious offering of Western art to date."

HIGHLIGHTS by CATEGORY

Fine & Rare Wines 25 & 26 May



The Cellars of the Historic Domaine Comte Georges de Vogüé on was 100% sold, which fetched a total of HK\$21,078,575/US\$2,699,271. Top lot of the auction was COMTE GEORGES DE VOGÜÉ, MUSIGNY BLANC 1990, 12 BOTTLES PER LOT (illustrated above), realizing HK\$367,500/US\$47,061.

The sale of Masseto and a Collection of Château Lafleur and other Guinaudeau Family Estate Wines totalled HK\$24,244,588/US\$3,104,703. Notable highlights include wines that were especially released from Masseto in original wooden cases and they were 100% sold. The top lot of this auction was HENRI JAYER, VOSNEROMANÉE CROS PARANTOUX 1985, 3 BOTTLES PER LOT, which realized HK\$588,000/ US\$75,298.

Asian 20th Century & Contemporary Art (Day Sales) 27 May





Asian Contemporary Art (Day Sale) totalled HK\$69,483,750/ US\$8,897,919 with 77% sold by lot and 90% by value. The top lot of the sale was *Pumpkins* by Yayoi Kusama, which realised HK\$7,060,000/ US\$904,086 (illustrated left).

Asian 20th Century Art (Day Sale) totalled HK\$127,618,750/US\$16,342,545 with 78% sold by lot and 87% by value. The top lot of the sale was *04.03.63* by Zao Wouki, which realised HK\$7,900,000/US\$1,011,655 (illustrated right).

26 May



Christie's Asian 20th Century & Contemporary Art and Contemporaries: Voices from East and West Spring Evening Sale took place on 26 May totalling HK\$1,040,390,000/US\$133,229,798 with 86% sold by lot and 93% by value, the highest ever evening sale total for Christie's in Asia.

The top lot of the sale was **Zao Wou-Ki's 14.12.59**, which sold for **HK\$176,725,000/ US\$22,630,971**, more than doubling its high estimate.

All proceeds of the sale will go to Save the Children, an independent organisation that has been providing the most vulnerable children with education, health and protection for almost 100 years.

Chinese Paintings 28 & 29 May





Chinese Contemporary Ink sale totalled HK\$25,526,250/US\$3,268,829, with 82% sold by lot and 93% sold by value. The top lot for the sale was *Play of Mountain and Cloud* by Liu Kuo-Sung, which realised HK\$5,380,000/US\$688,950 (illustrated top left).

Fine Chinese Classical Paintings and Calligraphy sale totalled HK\$69,811,250/ US\$ 8,939,858, with 68% sold by lot and 83% sold by value. The top lot for the sale was *Planting Bamboo* by Shen Zhou, which realised HK\$16,900,000/ US\$2,164,173 (illustrated bottom left).

Fine Chinese Modern Paintings sale totalled HK\$423,416,250/US\$54,221,649, with 74% sold by lot and 82% sold by value. The top lot for the sale was *Viewing the Waterfall* by Zhang Daqian, which realised HK\$64,225,000/US\$8,224,496 (illustrated right), while *Correspondences to Mr Hu Shifang* by Zhou Zuoren realised HK\$5,980,000/US\$765,784, and achieved a world auction record price for the artist.

Important Watches & Private Collections 28 May



The sale achieved **HK\$115,131,250/ US\$14,743,426**, selling 88% by lot and 85% by value.

Top lot of the sale was a ROLEX, AN 18K GOLD CHRONOGRAPH WRISTWATCH WITH "PAUL NEWMAN LEMON" DIAL, COSMOGRAPH, DAYTONA, PAUL NEWMAN LEMON MODEL, REF. 6264, CIRCA 1970 (illustrated left), which set a world auction record for this model at HK\$9,820,000/US\$1,257,525.

Three Qianlong Rarities - Imperial Ceramics From An Important Private Collection totalled HK\$160,425,000/ US\$20,547,882. Among the top lots for the sale was A Magnificent Blue And White Moonflask, which realised HK\$69,850,000/ US\$8,946,670 (illustrated first left).

Contemplating The Divine - Fine Buddhist Art totalled HK\$75,227,500/ US\$9,635,442. Among the top lots for the sale was A Magnificent And Extremely Rare Polychrome Wood Figure Of Water Moon *Guanyin*, which realised HK\$30,100,000/ US\$3,855,330 (illustrated second left).

<u>Leisurely Delights of a Transient Life</u> totalled HK\$103,570,000/ US\$13,265,664. Among the top lots for the sale was An Important And Extremely Rare Imperial Yellow Jade Hanging Vase And Cover, *Heting* You, which realised HK\$18,100,000/ US\$2,318,321 (illustrated third left).

Important Chinese Ceramics and Works of Art totalled HK\$119,983,750/ US\$15,368,003. Among the top lots for the sale was A Fine And Very Rare Blue And White Double-Gourd Vase, which realised HK\$36,100,000/ US\$4,623,834 (illustrated right).

The *Contemporary Art Asia: Hong Kong Edition* online sale which took place from 22-29 May and totaled **HK\$2,645,125**/ **US\$338,728**, and was 85% sold by lot and 90% sold by value.
