Live sales concluded 21 and 22 September with Important Chinese Ceramics and Works of Art, and online sales will continue until 28 September.

The top lots of Japanese and Korean Art were Hokusai's Kanagawa oki nami ura (Under the well of the Great Wave off Kanagawa) ["Great Wave"], which realized \$1,260,000, Toshusai Sharaku's Actor Ichikawa Komazo III as Shiga Daishichi, which realized \$277,200, and a gilt wood sculpture of a seated Buddha of the Joseon Dynasty brought \$201,600, five times its low estimate. The sale totaled \$3,334,464.

The top lots of South Asian Modern + Contemporary Art were Maqbool Fida Husain's *Untitled (Naga)* which realized \$1,260,000, Sayed Haider Raza's *Rajasthan*, which realized \$1,033,200, and Francis Newton Souza's *Untitled (Church on a Hill)*, which realized \$945,000. The sale made a total of \$11,020,590.

The top lots from the LJZ Collection of Chinese Jades were an Archaistic White Jade Rhyton from the Qianlong Period (1736-1795), which realized \$756,000, a White and Russet Jade Figure of a Mythical Beast from the Ming Dynasty, which realized \$302,400, and an 18th Century White Jade Figure of a Recumbent Horse, which realized \$226,800. The sale totaled \$2,639,700.
