Highlights included a full case of Gevrey-Chambertin Clos Saint Jacques 1962 from Rousseau which smashed through its pre-sale estimate of £7,000-9,000 making a remarkable £25,850. We also witnessed intense competition for a dozen bottles of Musigny Vieilles Vignes de Vogüé 1964 which made an impressive £25,850.
