CHRISTIE'S TO RE-INTROUDCE WATCH SALES IN REGION THIS OCTOBER

Dubai – From this October, Christie's Dubai will be re-launching their successful Watch sale, the only auction in this category to be held in the region, as part of their regular sale season.
